On 10 December 2010 at 14:30, the EU funded “Deaf Dialogue is Possible” project will hold an event dedicated to the International Day of Disabled Persons. The project will present its activities and achievements at the Deaf and Hard of Hearing Persons Training and Social Integration Centre (at 37-2 Kurghinyan alley Araratyan II, 0068 Yerevan).

The specific objective of the “Deaf Dialogue is Possible” project is to reinforce the development of the capacities of Deaf and Hard of Hearing Persons by setting up a Training and Social Integration Centre in Yerevan. The centre provides to its more than 600 beneficiaries free legal, psychological assistance, organizes literacy, sign language and vocational trainings with the aim of reintegration of the Deaf and Hard of Hearing persons into society.

The project is financed by the European Union (Euro 135,436), implemented and co-funded by the Association Arménienne d’Aide Sociale (Euro 60,000) in cooperation with the French Armenian Development Foundation and “Kamk ev Korov” Youth Disabled NGO.
